COMMENCEMENT OF CASES: A petition for reorganization under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code has been filed in this Court by each of the Debtors listed above, and orders for relief have been entered. You will not receive notice of all documents filed in these cases. All documents filed with the Court, including lists of the Debtors' property and debts, are available for inspection at the Office of the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court. In addition, such documents may be available at www.deb.uscourts.gov and at www.orleanshomesreorg.com.

PURPOSE OF CHAPTER 11 FILING: Bankruptcy cases under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code (title 11, United States Code) have been filed in this court by the Debtor(s) listed on the front side, and an order for relief has been entered. Chapter 11 allows the Debtors to reorganize or liquidate pursuant to a plan. A plan is not effective unless confirmed by the court. You may be sent a copy of the plan and a disclosure statement telling you about the plan, and you might have the opportunity to vote on the plan. You will be sent notice of the date of the confirmation hearing, and you may object to confirmation of the plan and attend the confirmation hearing. Unless a trustee is serving, the Debtors will remain in possession of the Debtors' property and may continue to operate any business.

CREDITORS MAY NOT TAKE CERTAIN ACTIONS: A creditor is anyone to whom a debtor owes money or property. Under the Bankruptcy Code, a debtor is granted certain protection against creditors. Common examples of prohibited actions by creditors are contacting a debtor to demand repayment, taking action against a debtor to collect money owed to creditors or to take property of a debtor, and starting or continuing foreclosure actions or repossessions. If unauthorized actions are taken by a creditor against a debtor, the Court may penalize that creditor. A creditor who is considering taking action against a debtor or the property of a debtor should review Bankruptcy Code § 362 and may wish to seek legal advice. **The staff of the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court is not permitted to give legal advice.**

MEETING OF CREDITORS: The Debtors' representative, as specified in Bankruptcy Rule 9001(5), is required to appear at the meeting of creditors on the date and at the place set forth above for the purpose of being examined under oath. Attendance by creditors at the meeting is welcomed, but not required. At the meeting, the creditors may examine the Debtors and transact such other business as may properly

come before the meeting. The meeting may be continued or adjourned from time to time by notice at the meeting, without further written notice to the creditors.

CLAIMS: Schedules of creditors will be filed pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 1007. Any creditor holding a scheduled claim, which is not listed as disputed, contingent, or unliquidated as to amount, may, but is not required to, file a proof of claim. Creditors whose claims are not scheduled or whose claims are listed as disputed, contingent, or unliquidated as to amount and who desire to participate in the case or share in any distribution must file their proofs of claim. A creditor who desires to rely on the schedule of creditors has the responsibility for determining that the claim is listed accurately. **Separate notice of the deadlines to file proofs of claim and proof of claim forms will be provided to the Debtors' known creditors.** Proof of claim forms are available in the clerk's office of any bankruptcy court. Proof of claim forms are also available from the Court's web site at www.deb.uscourts.gov or at the Debtors' website at www.orchestrasreorg.com. DISCHARGE OF DEBTS: Confirmation of a chapter 11 plan may result in a discharge of debts, which may include all or part of your debt. *See* Bankruptcy Code § 1141 (d). A discharge means that you may never try to collect the debt from the Debtors, except as provided in the plan.

BANKRUPTCY CLERK'S OFFICE: Any paper that you file in this bankruptcy case should be filed at the bankruptcy clerk's office at 824 North Market Street, 3rd Floor, Wilmington, DE 19801. You may inspect all papers filed, including the list of the Debtors' property and debts and the list of the property claimed as exempt, at the bankruptcy clerk's office.
